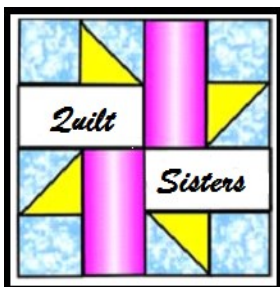

## January Workshop

### With Gloria Stahlhut

Gloria will share some samples and techniques for a new applique method. This method does not allow your fabric to ravel so there is no need to stitch the applique. However, if you still like the look of applique, it can be stitched after the application. In the workshop, you will create 2 different samples, one using applique and applying fabric to paper and the other with fabric applied to fabric. Materials will be included, and you will also receive your own adhesive so that you will be able to leave the class with creative ideas when you get home. This is a good workshop for those who love applique but also for those that have been cautious of doing applique due to the previous techniques. It is also amazing at how quick you can complete a project.
