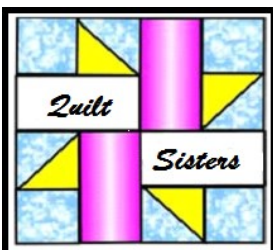

WORKSHOP INFORMATION

Workshops/open sews will be held on the Saturday after the KPQG monthly meeting.

There are several changes this year.

First and importantly is the change of location. We will be back at Indiana Wesleyan continuing the established hours of 10am to 3 pm. This move incurred a rental fee. Therefore, a small fee of \$5 for each attendee will be required and paid on the day of attendance. We will discontinue the raffle gifts at each workshop.

Great news for those attending. (A little something extra if you choose. You get something for your money and learn a little from a volunteer member.) Each month the committee will strive to have a small learning experience.

January's workshop program will be kicking off with Liz Dunham continuing our focus on fusible stabilizers, ironing on pieces and then sew 1/4" seams.

What you need to bring:

A approximately yard of light/medium

Weight iron on stabilizer

2 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares (estimate of 50 +. Great project for unused jelly roll Strips.)

Coordinating Thread

Rotary cutter, marking tool, and measuring Ruler.

Iron, ironing board, and cutting mat available for sharing

January Workshop with Gloria Stahlhut

Gloria will share some samples and techniques for a new applique method. This method does not allow your fabric to ravel so there is no need to stitch the applique. However, if you still like the look of applique, it can be stitched after the application. In the workshop, you will create 2 different samples, one using applique and applying fabric to paper and the other with fabric applied to fabric.. Materials will be included, and you will also receive your own adhesive so that you will be able to leave the class with creative ideas when you get home. This is a good workshop for those who love applique but also for those that have been cautious of doing applique due to the previous techniques. It is also amazing at how quick you can complete a project.

There will be \$25 fee for this class. It will cover the cost of the materials. She has one design for Valentine's day since we will be close to that day and the other will be able to create their own design and or she has some samples.

Items that are needed: ironing boards, irons, pressing cloth, and scissors.

NO needles, thread or sewing machine are needed.
