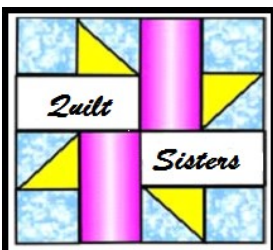

She has developed an interest in specialty rulers from Jaybird rulers, Sprigology rulers and the Quick Curve ruler.

She works at Quilt Expression, teaching a variety of classes that use specialty ruler techniques. She also
