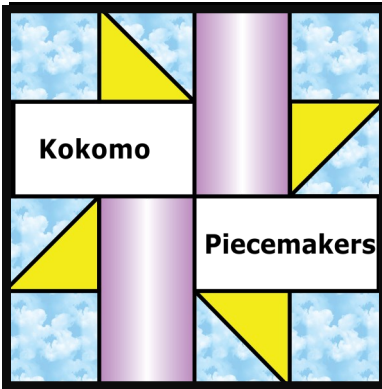

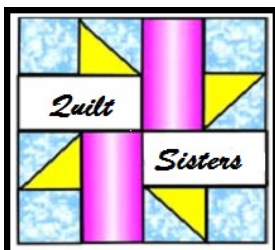

## 2020 Kokomo Piecemakers Quilt Show Challenge

I think that I shall never see a poem lovely  
as a tree -----

That's right. The 2020 quilt show challenge theme will be TREES!

Big trees, little trees, maple, oak, elm trees, pine trees, Christmas trees, a forest of trees, even just parts of trees. Trees with leaves, or blossoms or needles and cones, or with no leaves at all. Trees with birds or squirrels or a bear in a them.

Quilts can be pieced, appliqued, or pieced and appliqued.

They can be realistic, abstract, or artsy. They can be plain or embellished.

However they must be a real quilt – a top, a middle, and a backing sewn together by hand or machine stitching and bound on the edge. Maximum outer dimension cannot be more than 84 inches, whether it is square, rectangular or round.

So, turn on your creativity. Think about a special tree you planted, a Christmas tree that stirs memories, a vacation in the fall to Brown County, a tree you climbed when young, the tree in grandma's back yard that had a big swing.

Let your imagination go and join us this challenge.

Since the challenge quilt has a maximum perimeter of 84 inches here are measurements that will work in inches

Square - 21 x 21

Rectangles— 20 x 22

19 x 23

18 x 24

17 x 25

16 x 26

15 x 27

14 x 28

Circular— 26.75 diameter will be exact

25.5 diameter be close
