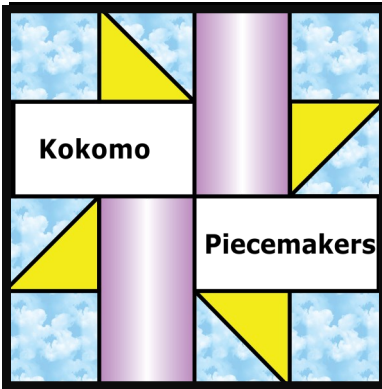

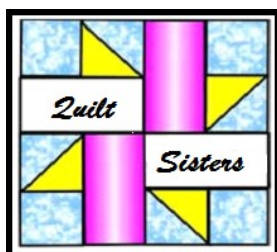

Square - 21 x 21

Rectangles— 20 x 22

19 x 23

18 x 24

17 x 25

16 x 26

15 x 27

14 x 28

Circular— 26.75 diameter will be exact

25.5 diameter be close
