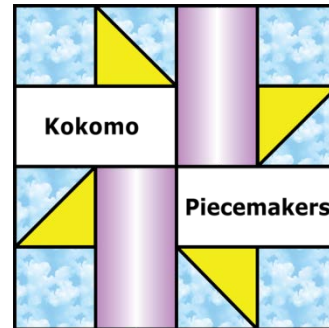


KPQG Name Tag

Friendship Four Patch

Instructions for a finished 4" x 4" name tag.



KPQG Logo

A is the Star Base

- Cut 2 pieces each 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" of primary color
- Cut 2 pieces each 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" of muslin or solid color (for your name and the Kokomo Piecemakers guild name)
 - Use a pigma pen for writing/printing your name on one muslin piece and the guild's name on the other piece. TIP: Before using the pigma pen, the writing /printing is easier and neater with freezer paper ironed onto the back of the muslin pieces.

B is the background

- Cut 8 pieces each 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

C is the Star

- Cut 4 pieces each 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

Use 1/4" seam allowances:

- Construct the star point unit B and C.
- Sew star point unit (B/C) to background (B). Be sure the star points are connected correctly to the background.
- Sew star point/background unit to star base (A) to make one complete patch.
- Sew four "patches" together. TIP: Use the diagram to be sure your star points are going in the right direction.
- The block now measures 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Batting: Cut one 4 1/2" square

Backing: Cut one 4 1/2" square

One metal clasp

Layer the batting on the bottom, next the wrong side of block onto the batting, and third, the right side of the backing onto the right side of the block. Stitch 1/4" seam on all sides leaving an opening large enough to turn the name tag right side out. Trim corners, turn right side out and close the opening with a slip stitch.

Attach the clasp to the back with thread or a glue gun.
