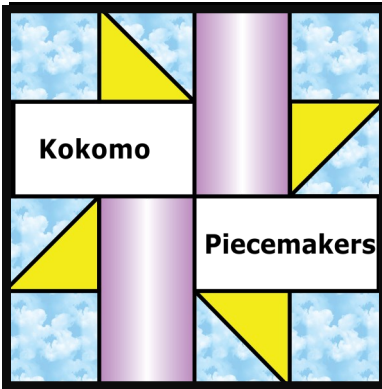

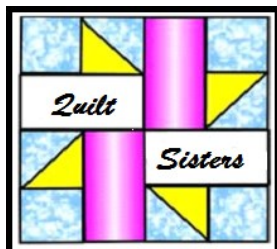

A popular teacher, Marti has traveled extensively, having taught in 49 states and 26 countries. Marti is the recipient of two prestigious quilt industry "lifetime achievement" awards, The Silver Star(2004) and the Michael Kile Award(1991).

Doris lives in Kendallville, Indiana, and her home page (www.doris-goins.com) states she is a lover of all things quilted. She began quilting as an adult in 1992, and has been a longarm quilter since 1996. Though she does not currently quilt for others, Doris does continue to teach basic classes to new longarm quilters.
