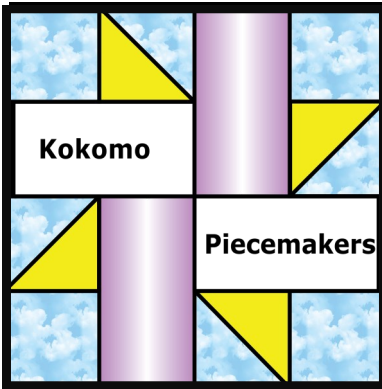

Union Hall Parking

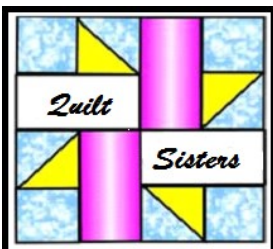
Hall management has asked that we park on park on the west side of the building. There is an entrance into the meeting room from that parking lot.
